Heat and Drought Stress



Trees will often drop leaves in response to drought. Though usually a general thinning, in severe cases the tree can lose all leaves and enter a period of summer dormancy.



Drought and heat stress on hosta.



Leaf roll due to a lack of water.



Scorch due to drought.



Turf can go dormant for 5 to 8 weeks without harm.



Scorch on maple due to heat and/or drought.
